Title: CONSIDER AND TAKE POSSIBLE ACTION TO: AMEND THE SB 1882 PARTNERSHIP

AGREEMENT WITH MI ESCUELITA (CASA VIEW CENTER), (NOT TO EXCEED \$900

PER STUDENT, PER YEAR / 1882 FUNDS).

TEA granted provisional approval to the PreK Partnership 1882 contracts. In order to get full approval and have the 1882 per student funding paid, the district was told to edit four sections in each contract. Those sections are shown below so the board can see the tracked changes. These edits do not change the substance or intent of the partnerships. New text is underlined and removed text is crossed out.

- 1) 9.01.2 Teaching Staff: OP shall select and manage the School's teachers, teaching assistants, paraprofessionals, curriculum specialists, program coordinators, and any other academic instructional role, who may be employed by either the District or OP. OP shall select from a pool of qualified candidates provided by the District and employed by the District, the teacher of record for each class as the teacher of record for each class a qualified, certified teacher employed by the District.
 That teacher shall meet all certification and hiring requirements of the District.
- 2) 9.02.1 *Teaching Staff:* The District shall provide a pool of qualified teacher <u>candidates</u> to the OP, from whom the OP shall choose the teacher of record for the Prekindergarten partnership class. The District shall retain employment of the teacher of record.
- 3) 9.02.2 Administration: The District shall employ and provide a certified principal to support, supervise, and evaluate all District teachers located at the School. OP will also have full autonomy concerning an employee at the School, including initial and final authority over the assignment of all District employees to the campus, as well as initial and final authority to supervise, manage, evaluate, and rescind the assignment of any district employee from the campus Notwithstanding any additional employee evaluation instrument it elects to implement, OP agrees to effectuate the District's Teacher Excellence Initiative ("TEI") when evaluating its teachers in accordance with the District's policies, administrative procedures, and timelines. The evaluations shall not interfere with OP final authority on which employees are assigned to work at the school.
- 4) 12.04 Assessments. OP has sole authority over the selection and administration of student assessments not required by state or federal law or not required to comply with the Student Outcome Goals.
